TOURNAMENTS

1. JORDANELLE (LAST TOURNAMENT OF 2010)
2. TBF QUALIFIER @ LAKE POWELL, APRIL 2-3
3. BCB OPEN @ PELICAN, MAY 7TH (NO AOY POINTS)
4. TBF QUALIFIER @ FLAMING GORGE, JUNE 18-19
5. MANTUA, JULY 9TH
6. PINEVIEW, AUGUST 13TH
7. LAKE POWELL IN CONJUNCTION /W TICABOO BASS, OCTOBER 7-8

TOURNAMENT RULES

- 1) You must be a paid club member to participate in a tournament.
- 2) You must fill out and sign a copy of the tournament and angler of the year rules
- 3) You must sign up with a co-angler to guarantee the use of your boat.
- 4) If there are two people without co-anglers we will draw at the lake to see who takes their boat and who is the co-angler
- 5) Preregistration is required and there will be a meeting one week prior to the tournament to pay, signup and determine launch time.
- 6) There will be no late sign ups accepted.
- 7) You will be allowed to pay the tournament director or the president at any time up to one week prior to the tournament.
- 8) Angler and co-angler need to agree on fuel, fishing location, and anything else prior to launch. If an agreement can't be reached then it will be dealt with at that time. No actions will be taken by the club after this.
- 9) Life vests are to be worn whenever the big engine is running.
- 10) You must remain in your boat while fishing in the tournament, unless there is an emergency (this includes restroom breaks)
- 11) All weights will be determined by the use of the club issued scales or the golden rule method. You will be told what method we are using at the ramp, and that will be the only method accepted that tournament.
- 12) The person who did not catch the fish is responsible for the measuring of the fish.
- 13) All fish will be immediately measured and released.
- 14) The angler will keep track of the co-anglers weight slip and vice versa.
- 15) The winner will be determined by the angler with the highest five fish weight.
- 16) If you have any questions about things not brought up ask the tournament director.
- 17) Any disputes need to be brought to the tournament directors attention before we leave the lake.
- 18) If a dispute arises it will be dealt with at the lake and the tournament directors ruling is final.

19) Every angler is required to turn in their weight sheet. Even if no fish were caught or they were not near the top. They may play a role in the AOY race and this is important to some.

ANGLER OF THE YEAR

POINTS SCORING

- 1) Anglers and co-anglers will compete separately for prizes and AOY.
- 2) There will be a total of 51 points available at every tournament (angler and co-anglers).
- 3) 25 show up points will be awarded to every angler.
- 4) The first place angler will receive 25 points
- 5) Second receives 23, after that there will be 1 point less for every spot. (third 22, fourth 21, so on)
- 6) There will be one point awarded for big fish.
- 7) There will be no other points awarded
- 8) Anglers will be allowed to drop two tournaments. This allows for people not interested in the state team to skip the qualifiers.
- 9) After the tournament season is over we will tally all anglers best five tournaments and the winner will be determined.
- 10) The tournaments that we are holding in conjunction with the federation qualifiers are two day total weight.
- 11) One big fish will be determined by the biggest fish caught by a B.C.B. Club member over both days. (only big fish point will be awarded at each qualifier)

I HAVE READ AND FULLY UNDERSTAND THESE RULES. IF ANY QUESTIONS SHOULD ARISE THEY WILL BE BROUGHT IMMEDIATELY TO THE TOURNAMENT DIRECTOR AND DEALT WITH.
